Lenten Reflection: "God's Justice is Mercy": "The Sacred Scripture presents God as infinite mercy, but also as perfect justice. He continually offers us His forgiveness, He helps us to welcome Him and to be aware of our evil so as to free ourselves of it. God does not seek our condemnation, only our salvation. God does not wish to condemn anyone! ... The Lord of Mercy wishes to save everyone. ... The problem is letting Him enter into our heart. God's heart is the heart of a Father Who loves all His children and wants them to live in

goodness and justice, and therefore to live in fullness and happiness. It is precisely a Father's heart that we encounter when we go to the confessional. Perhaps it will tell us something to better understand our evil, but at the confessional we all go in search of a father who will help us change our life; a father who gives us the strength to go on; a father who forgives us in God's name". 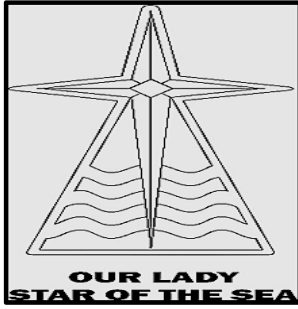
