EVANGELISATION EVENT: A Diocese of Menevia Evangelisation event will be held on Saturday 10th August at Sacred Heart Parish, Morryston, starting at 10.30am with Holy Mass. This will be followed by a Talk (title: I WILL PUT MY SPIRIT IN YOU) by Fr Michael Akpoghiran OP in the Parish Hall. This event will include a presentation on the Diocese of Menevia School of Evangelisation and Catechetics (DOMSEC) which will start running courses in the autumn. You will get information about courses, training, events and how you can be involved in the work of evangelisation in the Diocese. Please bring a packed lunch. See notice board for more information.

COURSE ON NEW EVANGELISATION: Offered by the Diocese of Menevia School of Evangelisation and Catechetics (DOMSEC), this course starts 21st September and 28th September in Morryston Parish and St Joseph's Port Talbot respective. The course is intended for any individual who desires to develop the ability to proclaim the Gospel to others in New Evangelisation context. New Evangelisation is needed in those situations in which many are baptised but few practise, or where people have drifted or have no real, personal and dynamic relationship with Christ and his Church. This course prepares and inspires new evangelisers who will invite others to a rich and deep experience of Christ in his Church. Application forms are available in the porch. COURSE ON SCRIPTURE, SPIRITUALITY AND EVANGELISATION: Starting February 2020 and offered by DOMSEC. The course will cover a general introduction to the scriptures and their respective books and a study of some church documents on scriptures in relation to Catechesis and Evangelisation. Participants will deepen their knowledge of the Scriptures. This course will equip participants to share the word of God, deepen their spiritual life and defend their faith. It will give participants the confidence to become agents of Evangelisation.
