**FACE COVERINGS AT MASS:** The Welsh Government have announced that from 14/9/20 the wearing of face coverings will be compulsory in shops and in other enclosed public spaces. This will apply to adults and children aged 11 and over. There is evidence that the wearing of face coverings reduces the risk of passing on Covid-19 and other respiratory viruses to others and even if you feel well you may still carry the virus. For these reasons, you will now need to wear a face covering when you attend Mass. The face covering may be removed in order to receive Holy Communion. By wearing a face covering you will be helping to protect others.
