

From Archbishop Mark O'Toole: Mass with the Imposition of the Pallium

The Apostolic Nuncio, Archbishop Miguel Maury Buendia, will vest Archbishop Mark O'Toole with the pallium at a Mass on Thursday 22nd June at 11.30am, at St David's Cathedral Cardiff.

The pallium, made of lamb's wool, is a white band measuring about 5 cm in width. Two equally wide bands, about 30 cm long containing small silk-covered lead pieces, extend one in front and one on the back.

The pallium is worn over the chasuble and is the insignia of the office of a metropolitan archbishop, that is, of an archbishop who is the bishop of a metropolitan archdiocese.
