Saint Thomas Aquinas on the Eucharist

This sacrament has a threefold significance. One concerns the past, since it commemorates our Lord's Passion, which was a true sacrifice, and in this respect, it is called a "Sacrifice."

About the present, it is called "Communion" because we communicate with Christ through it, both because we partake of His flesh and Godhead, and because we communicate with and are united to one another through it.

Looking towards the future, this sacrament holds a third meaning. It is a promise of the Divine fruition that awaits us in heaven, and in this sense, it is called 'Viaticum' because it paves the way for us to reach that eternal destination. In this light, it is also known as the 'Eucharist,' meaning 'good grace,' for it really contains Christ, who is 'full of grace.'
