<u>DOMINICAN PRIEST TO BECOME CARDINAL</u>: Dominican priest Father Timothy Radcliffe OP, currently serving as spiritual adviser and preacher at the second session of the 16th Ordinary Assembly of the Synod of Bishops, is set to be elevated to the rank of Cardinal by Pope Francis. After his Sunday Angelus, on 6 October, Pope Francis announced that he will hold a Consistory for the creation of new Cardinals on 8 December 2024, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception. Father Radcliffe is an English Dominican friar who served as Master of the Order of Preachers (the Dominicans) from 1992 to 2001. The Consistory will take place before the opening of the 2025 Jubilee of Hope and after the conclusion of the Second Session of the so-called Synod on Synodality in the Vatican.
