About Carlo Acutis

Carlo Acutis (3 May 1991 – 12 October 2006) was a British-born Italian website designer who documented Eucharistic miracles and approved Marian apparitions, and catalogued both on a website he designed before his death from leukaemia at 15. He was buried in Assisi, Italy. Before his death in 2006, he offered his sufferings for Pope Benedict XVI and for the Church, saying: "I offer all of my suffering to the Lord for the pope and for the Church in order not to go to purgatory but to go straight to heaven." Carlo Acutis was noted for his cheerfulness, computer skills, and devotion to the Eucharist.

He was beatified by Pope Francis on 10 October 2020. After a second miracle attributed to the intercession of Carlo was confirmed in May 2024, Pope Francis granted approval for his canonization, which is scheduled for 27 April 2025.

- Carlo's witness of faith as a child led adults to convert and be baptised.
- Carlo wasn't afraid to defend Church teaching, even in situations when his classmates disagreed with him.
- Carlo was a faithful friend. He was known for standing up for kids at school who got bullied, especially kids with disabilities.
- Carlo was fascinated with computer coding and taught himself some of the basic coding languages, including C and C++.
- Carlo loved playing video games.
