## Supporting the Education of Dominican Priests who Serve Us

Fr Jude has been with us for nearly two years, and his presence has been a blessing to our parish. We are delighted that he loves the parish and Mumbles and is very happy being here. He is following in the footsteps of previous Dominican priests in Mumbles (Fr Victor and Fr Matthew), who served our parish, studied here in Swansea, and returned to Nigeria to use their acquired skills and experience. Similarly, Fr Jude began a master's degree course in Management at Swansea University last autumn. This course, spread over two academic years, costs £10,850 per academic year (international student tuition fee). Last August, you, our wonderful parishioners, raised £6,055, exceeding our target, to enable him to complete the first academic year. Thank you!

When our Dominican priests study here, we, the Dominican Province of Nigeria, always have to pay their tuition fees. Thankfully, you, the parishioners, have been very generous in supporting the tuition fees of our Dominican priests who have served our parish. Your unwavering support and outstanding generosity have made it possible to train Fr Victor, Fr Matthew, and now Fr Jude. Once again, we are appealing for your kindness. As a parish community, we have always stood by our priests, and now, we have another opportunity to support Fr Jude to enable him to complete the final year of his studies. This is not just an individual effort, but a collective one that reflects our shared commitment to our priests and their service.

We propose to raise £5,850. A donor has pledged to match this amount with £5,000, almost doubling the impact of our collective effort to the required £10,850.
